The one day workshop can be run for groups by arrangement in other locations.

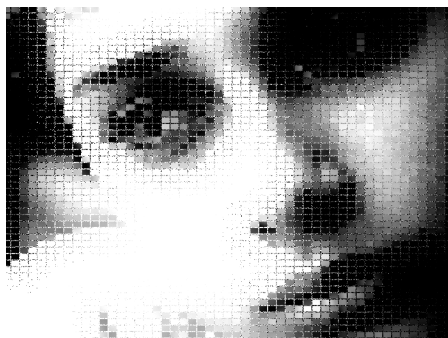
